

Key Components:

- A music lead who is passionate about their subject and delivers CPD to all staff.
- A bespoke music curriculum that captivates creativity.
- **All pupils:** attend our 30 minute whole school singing assembly every wednesday.
- **EYFS-** weekly music lessons using the Jolly Music Scheme alongside other resources.
- **KS1-** weekly music lesson following Kodaly as laid out in the model music curriculum via the Jolly Music scheme and Sing up.
- **KS2-** Receive a 60 minute music lesson fortnightly following the Kodaly method, Sing up and Kaboom percussion.
- A Young Voices choir open to Years 4, 5 and 6.
- Whole school performance opportunities, both as part of our curriculum and as an extra curricular activity.
- Whole school music team, with a curriculum lead, and a small dedicated team of peri tutors, including piano, keyboard, drums, bass guitar and electric guitar.
- Funded places are available for those receiving Pupil Premium.
- Music technology is available on Chromebooks.
